between the island and the mainland.**



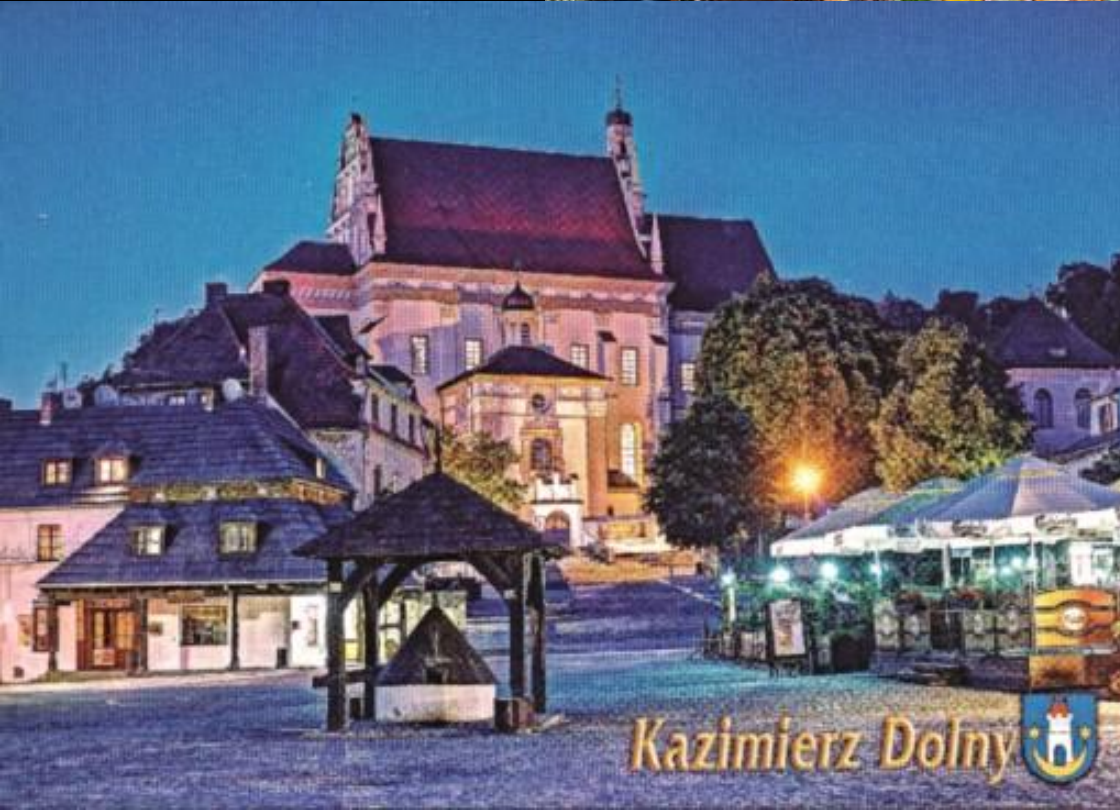


Malbork Castle is the largest castle in the world.

The Copernicus Science Centre is one of the largest science centres in Europe. Its exhibition is divided into six interdisciplinary parts with over 400 exhibits.

The Salt mine in Wieliczka is the most popular mine in Poland. The biggest and the most beautiful underground chapel in the mine is the chapel of St. Kinga.



Wrocław is the Polish city that's a home to 350 dwarves. Mostly bronze, often cheeky, and each about a foot tall.



The Siklawa waterfall is the biggest waterfall in the Tatras.



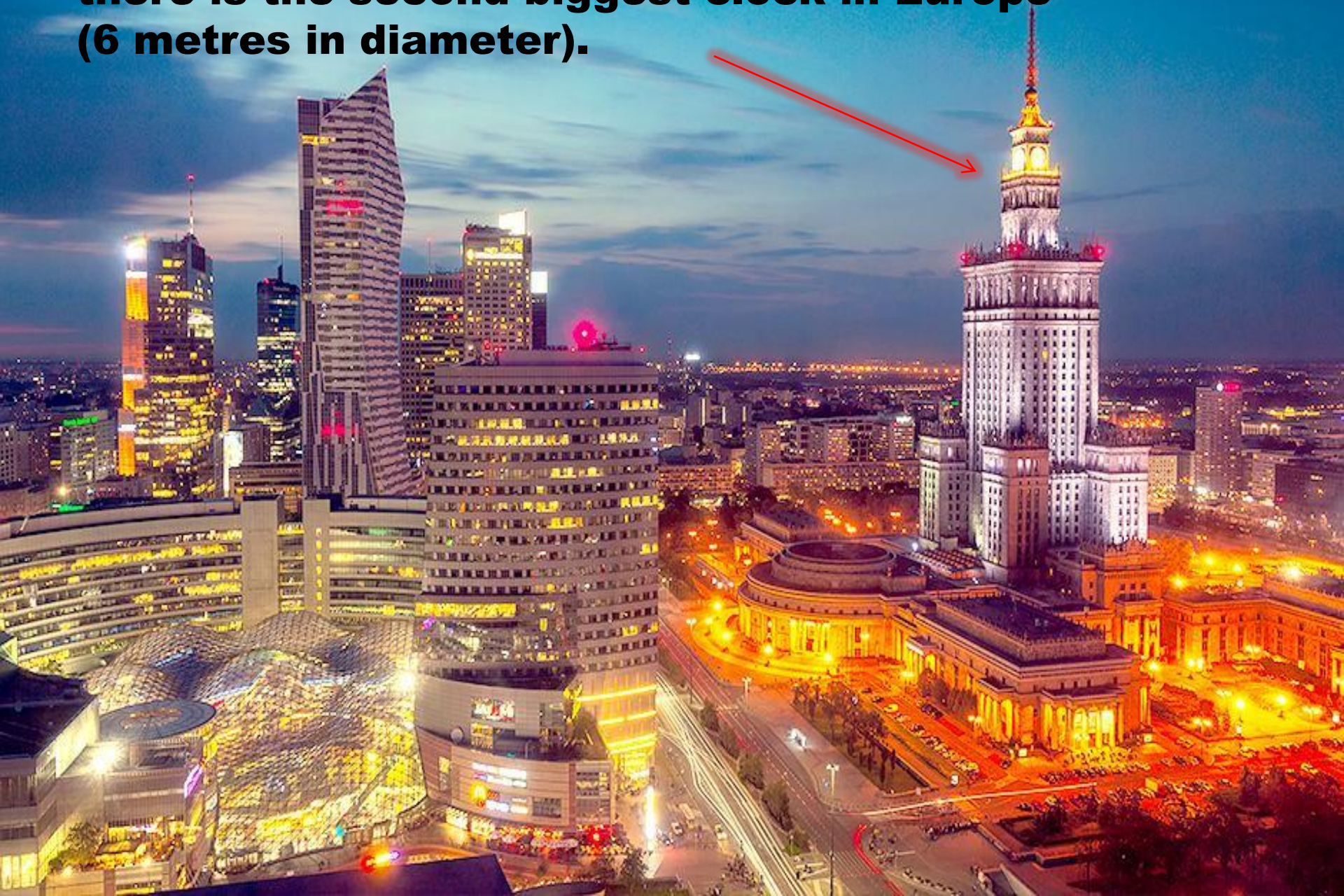
Radom is bigger than Paris, but in Paris the number of inhabitants is ten times bigger than in Radom.
